By visiting our school campus you are guaranteed the warmest of welcomes and a chance to see what makes our school so special.



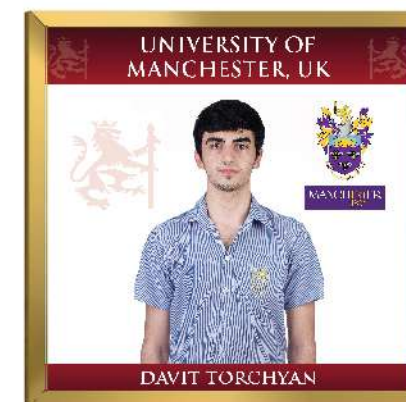

Regent's Early Years sees fully qualified teachers commit themselves to the healthy development and growth of children aged 2-5 years old.

The classes are split into three groups (Pre-Nursery, Nursery and Reception) and each child benefits from the care and attention they receive from

both their class teachers and teaching assistants in small classes.

PRIMARY



The Primary School attends to each child's individual needs to learn, explore and grow. As a school we firmly believe that learning should be fun, relevant to the child, hands-on and engaging.

Our team of fully qualified and dedicated teachers introduce English, Mathematics and Science at age-appropriate levels. All of our students

have physical education lessons, including swimming, the creative arts, including music and drama, and foreign languages.

All students, no matter what background, achieve the ability to think, learn and communicate in English.

Our children leave the Primary School with the skills, attributes and mindset to fully absorb the challenge of Secondary School.

SECONDARY



Students aged 11-14 (Years 7 to 9) study the core subjects of Mathematics, English and Science within the British National Curriculum. Aged 14-16 they work towards the prestigious and internationally recognised IGCSE examinations (Years 10 and 11).

Creative arts, sports and the holistic values of Round Square are instilled throughout

the Secondary School and students are given opportunities to expand their interests outside lessons through community service and after school activities.

Our student community is one that is made up of individuals who are responsible and respectable citizens and who develop thoughtfulness, compassion and strength.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB)



The International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma qualification is recognised and accepted by the best universities around the world. Students aged 16-18 years old study subjects that ensure breadth of experience in languages, social studies, the sciences and mathematics with an additional choice of a subject in the arts.

The mandatory Extended Essay (EE) and Creativity, Action and Service (CAS) give students the means to learn through experience, to take action in the service of others and to demonstrate independent learning.

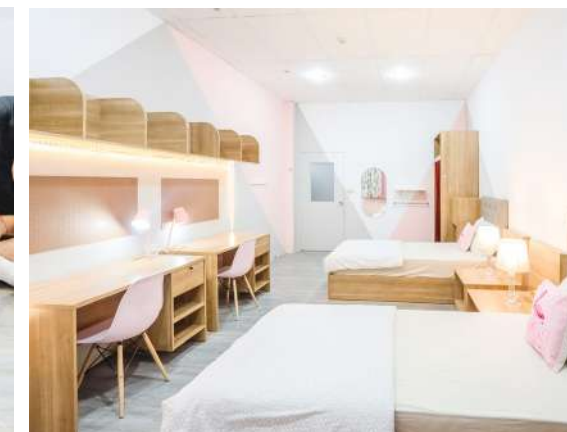
Universities now demand more than academic success, so we provide our students with a platform to gain the extra skills required to meet these high standards.

The Regent's International School, Bangkok is fully accredited by the International Baccalaureate Organization and the Council of International Schools. The school is a member of The International Schools Association, Thailand and Thailand International Schools Activities Committee. The school is also a member of the Federation of British International Schools in Asia and is also recognised by the Diplomatic Corps in Thailand for their children.

Regent's is a Global Member of the prestigious Round Square Association, with HM King Constantine, its President, and HRH Prince Andrew as patrons.

All 180 Round Square schools around the world believe it is their obligation to produce well-rounded leaders for our future global community. As Round Square schools, they instil six values at the heart of what their students do, both within and beyond the classroom. These six values are known as the 'Six Pillars'; taken in the 'right' order, their first letters memorably and appropriately spell out the acronym 'IDEALS', which stands respectively for International awareness, Democracy, Environmental responsibility, Adventure, Leadership and Service to others. Our sense of achievement as a school comes from translating these IDEALS into practical realities as part of the curriculum.



OUR SUCCESS

The key to our success lies in the quality of our teaching staff and their commitment to being excellent role models for all students. All our main teachers possess UK Qualified Teacher Status or Equivalent. We place priority on the recruitment of such teachers. Apart from foreign language teachers, all our teaching staff are native English speakers and nearly 90% are British. Oxford, Cambridge, London School of Economics, Imperial College London, University College London, the Royal College of Music London, Stanford, MIT, Wharton (University of Pennsylvania), UC Berkeley, the National University of Singapore and Seoul National University are among the prestigious universities which have offered places to our recent graduates (in some cases with full scholarships).



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
