CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

We have four year groups at Regent's Langsuan: Pre-nursery, Nursery, Reception and Year 1. At Regent's International School, Langsuan Campus, we follow the English Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum (EYFS) and the English National Curriculum (ENC). The EYFS curriculum is divided into seven areas of learning. There are 3 prime areas:

- Communication and language
- Physical development
- Personal, social and emotional development

As children grow, the prime areas will support them to develop skills in 4 specific areas:

- Literacy
- Mathematics
- Expressive arts and design
- Understanding the world

These areas are used to plan your child's learning which has been designed to suit your child's unique needs. Children learn by playing and exploring, being active and also through creative and critical thinking which takes place both indoors and outdoors. At the end of the EYFS (which will be the end of Reception), your child will have covered all of these aspects.

Following their time in Reception, children then move to Year 1. The English National Curriculum (ENC) covers:

- English
- Mathematics
- Science
- Computing
- Art and Design
- Design Technology
- History
- Geography
- Personal Social and Health Education
- Music
- Physical Education

Children will also learn Thai and Mandarin in all year groups.



SPORTS AND CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

All children enjoy PE and swimming coaching each week. Regent's co-curricular activities programme is an opportunity for students to discover new learning experiences and to develop valuable life skills through a fun and creative set of projects, clubs, awards and activities.

Our young children will be able to choose from a rich programme of after-school activities that focus on their social, emotional, physical and creative development. A diverse range of clubs will be offered, including swimming, arts and crafts, literacy, problem-solving, Mandarin and mathematics. Classes will also be available for piano, guitar, violin, cello, drums, hip hop, ballet, street dance, yoga and Thai dance.

PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT

We value our parent partnerships at Regent's and encourage our parents to be actively involved in their child's learning. We regularly offer parental workshops in the Early Years department throughout the year. These include workshops on how to support your child with mathematics at home and training for parents in how we teach phonics.

After their final year at the Langsuan Campus, students will receive a guarantee that they can continue their studies until they graduate from IB at our main, Rama 9 campus. Regent's provides shuttle buses for students who choose to further their studies in the Primary and Secondary (IGCSE & IB) programmes at our main campus. The main campus is close to the city campus - only a 20-minute drive.

Regent's Rama 9 Campus offers the English National Curriculum in Primary and Lower Secondary until Year 9 (age 14). Students then prepare for IGCSE in Years 10 and 11 (ages 14-16) before moving onto the pre-university IB Diploma Programme in Years 12 and 13 (ages 16-18). Students come from over 35 nationalities.

Our academic results are excellent; our students score some of the best IGCSE and IB results in Thailand and South East Asia, before attending some of the top universities in the world. We also have a fantastic extra-curricular provision. The school works hard to cultivate a friendly, happy family atmosphere whilst maintaining high standards and expectations.
